Youth under 16 must be certified to operate tractors on public roads or work near dangerous equipment on farms. Certification may be obtained by successfully completing the Tractor and Farm Machinery Safety Training Course offered by the Jefferson County UW-Extension Office and local ag instructors.

When: January 5, 19, 26; February 2, 9, 16; May 7

Time: 1/5 - 8-12:30 p.m.; all other dates 8—Noon

Where: UW-Extension, Jefferson County Office

May 7 — Jefferson County Fair Park (driving exam)

Cost: \$35 per participant

A parent or legal guardian must attend with their youth on January 5 for the beginning of the class. Youth must attend ALL classes and pass the written and driving exam for certification.
