

## JEFFERSON COUNTY 4-H DAIRY PROJECT POINT CARD

Starting July 1, 2019 (for the 2020 Jefferson County Fair) the Jefferson County 4-H Dairy Committee will be implementing a point system for all dairy project members that wish to receive showmanship jackpot money.

- This does not discourage anyone from participating in showmanship. Youth may still participate without points; however, they will NOT receive showmanship jackpot money. In addition, if the showmanship winner is not within the points card requirements, they WILL NOT be able to have a seat in the MAP Auction.
- In order for a dairy exhibitor to be eligible to receive their portion of the showmanship jackpot money, they will need to earn the required points before the Mandatory Meeting (typically third Tuesday, June 2020).
- The points are divided into educational, fundraising, and dairy project related events.
- First year members to the dairy project and post high school (last year in the dairy project) are EXEMPT from the points card requirement.
- **Grades 3-8 are required to earn 4 points; Grades 9-12 are required to earn 6 points.**

NOTE: Youth that participate in the 4-H Dairy Quiz Bowl and the 4-H Dairy Judging Teams have the potential to receive all their points from participating if they meet the coach's expectations and compete in a competition.

**Please make sure you get the initials of a Dairy Committee member for each activity to earn points.**
