Establishment- The Scott E. Skalitzky Memorial Scholarship has been established to deserving graduates to continue their education in the areas of agriculture, mechanics, natural resources or special emphasis. .

Scholarship requirements:

- Full time senior enrolled in a high school within an area that Scott knew or worked
- Student must have been enrolled for at least two consecutive semester prior to graduation
- FFA or 4-H member in good standing
- Applicant must have applied and /or been accepted in a certified program of study in the above listed criteria
- Three letters of recommendation from the following:
 - a. teacher or counselor
 - b. 4-H or FFA advisor
 - c. community
- Transcript of grades

Awarding of Funds:

The recipient will be notified by their school by May 1st of his or her award and will be required to complete a news release or have their name used with the scholarship presentation. The scholarship monies will be disbursed directly to the individual upon a successful completion of the first semester. The applicant must maintain a 2.0 GPA. A copy of the first semester transcript will be required for verification.
