

Family Information – 2022-23 4-H Fundraiser

Purpose: To raise funds to further the 4-H program. Profit is shared between the 4-H Leaders' Association and participating clubs. Clubs receive \$1.00 per item sold. All 4-H families are encouraged to sell and purchase for their own use in addition to outside sales. Clubs must participate in some capacity in the Pizza and Pie Fundraiser or the club will be charged an additional \$20 per member fee.

Product: Please review the sales flyers before selling.

- Pine Cone Restaurant in Johnson Creek will be our *local* pie supplier. With Pine Cone, buyers can purchase two different certificates. One can only be used for pies (our profit margin on this certificate is greater) and one is for bake goods and restaurant bills. Pine Cone pies will be **FRESH** and picked up on different days per club assignment. Please check with your club on delivery date and time of your Pine Cone Pies.
- Poyer's Market in Fort Atkinson will offer gift certificates for our fundraiser and can be redeemed for fresh pies AND other items in the store. Certificates may be used for items such as pies, cheese cakes, plants, other baked goods, etc.
- Emil's Pizza in Watertown will be our local pizza supplier.

1. **August - September 23** Sale is OPEN. Sell Pizzas, Pies, and Gift Certificates.

2. **Sale Tips and Suggestions:**

- Start with your own order, stock up for the winter months and holiday season.
- Make a plan of who you will sell to and where. Sell early, submit orders early.
- DO NOT sell at or near a place of business.
- NEVER GO ALONE. Door-to-door selling should be done with an adult.
- BE PREPARED.
- Give customer your name and 4-H club; say that we are raising money so that 4-H can continue in our communities. Be ready to describe some of your 4-H activities if the customer asks.
- Give Customer order forms to review, order and sign. Bring extra pens. Remember payment is upon delivery of product.
- Encourage customer to stock up for the winter and holiday season.
- Promote Gift Certificates to give as gifts or to redeem for any item at Poyer's Market in Fort Atkinson or Pine Cone in Johnson Creek.

3. Make arrangements for delivery and customer payment on **Saturday, November 5, 2022** for all Emil's Pizzas.

4. Make arrangements for delivery of Pine Cone Pies (**they are fresh pies**) on your designated club pick up day.

5. Fresh Pine Cone pies will be picked up at Pine Cone Restaurant on a designated pick up day by your Pizza & Pie Captain. You will be notified of your pick up time.

6. Emil's Pizza will be picked up on November 5th at the Jefferson County Fair Park. Each individual/family is responsible to pick up and pay for their orders using the drive through pick up system (similar to the previous fundraiser).

7. Individual/family orders must be submitted online through a Google Form - **Orders must be submitted by Monday, September 26th**. No late submissions will be accepted.

8. Write out **ONE CHECK** to pay for your entire order at the time of distribution. Make check payable to Jefferson County 4-H Leaders Association for the entire amount of your family's order.
